Talon Hart gave close to a twenty minute presentation about the B.C.A.A. program and what it has to offer, and the benefits of the road side assistance program.

Here are some of the highlights.

The plus membership will give you up to 160 km free towing to the closest repair shop. Also will tow to ferry and from ferry to home but will not cover tow truck and driver or ferry cost, that is policy holders responsibility.

B.C.A.A. has an affiliation with Totem Towing along with mainland tow companies, overseas and U.S. connections.

BCAA also has its own ramp trucks.

Also has a free Safe ride home feature (only once a year.)

Premier card offers free 2 day car rental once a year, also offers \$100.00 coverage for locksmith.

If you are not a member when you have a problem, you can call them and join up, you will automatically be signed up as a plus member when you do this and they will then honour your claim.
