### Minutes -Regular meeting April 17<sup>th</sup> 2019

#### Secretary's report:

#### **Osoyoos Cactus Jalopies Car Show:**

Most members except John Fleury have received online registration confirmation. No registration numbers have been provided; presumably we will receive these at the show registration. Some members are leaving Wednesday bright and early going to a ghost town in the US on route to Osoyoos, others are leaving early Thursday morning.

Bob Bentham followed up on a rumour of rooms not being confirmed. No outstanding confirmations were found. There are still rooms available at Best Western from \$149 to \$179.

#### **Club BBQ and Poker Run:**
