Secretary's report:

The February minutes were distributed by email. No errors or omissions were reported.

Motion: To accept the February minutes as distributed made by **Bob Rivers**, seconded by **John Fleury**. **All in favour, none opposed, carried.**

Treasurer's report:

Balance forward from last month was reported at \$6241.25. Income for the month included 50/50 proceeds of \$25.50 plus \$600.00 in 2019 membership dues deposited in the bank. Our expenses for the month included \$830.00 for club liability insurance as well as \$52.50 to Caorda Web Solutions for website expenses. Balance forward is **\$5934.25**. No outstanding debts in this report.

Motion: To accept the treasurer's report as stated, made by **Loyd Houston**, seconded by **Ken Clark**. **All in favour, none opposed, carried.**

Old Business:

New Club Jackets:

After much discussion at the last meeting and to maintain a standardized look for the club, the executive has decided that our jacket color will be black. Loyd Houston had samples for sizing at his home and 18 people have confirmed the right fit. We need a minimum order of 25 to benefit from discount pricing from Mega Screen who will be adding the specialized crests. **Payment in full will be required by April 17th, our next meeting date.**

Size confirmation will also be required by that date for those who have not tried the jackets on for fit. This is strongly recommended as this particular manufacturer's product tends to fit slightly smaller than others. Final pricing will not be available until all orders have been confirmed. We will be charging a set price for the jackets and crests. If the final price is less due to a large number of orders, you will be reimbursed. The costs are as follows:

Jacket: \$50.00. Small front crest only: add \$20.00, Large back crest only: add \$75.00
Both front and back crests: add \$100.00

Roster and membership update:

James Robinson reported that the roster book pages are done and ready for printing. However we still have about 30 members who have not paid their 2019 membership dues. Printing will be delayed until after month end to confirm who has renewed and who may be leaving the club.
